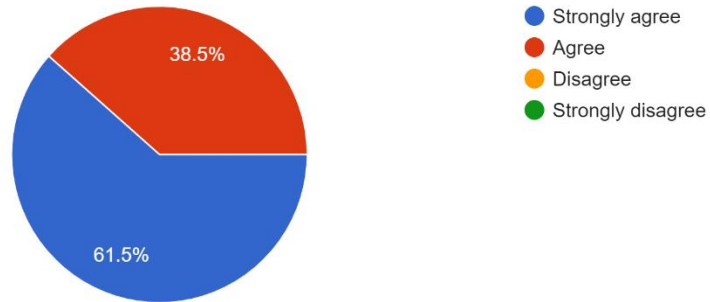

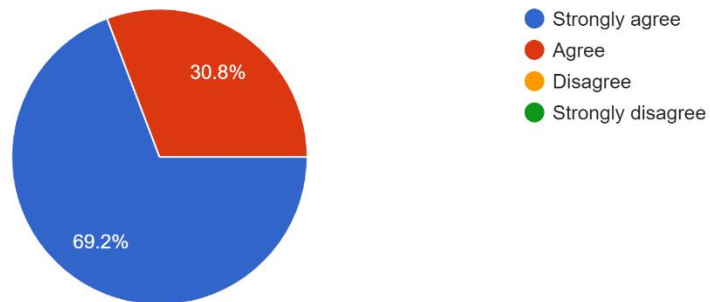
Grove Street Primary School is welcoming for children, parents and families

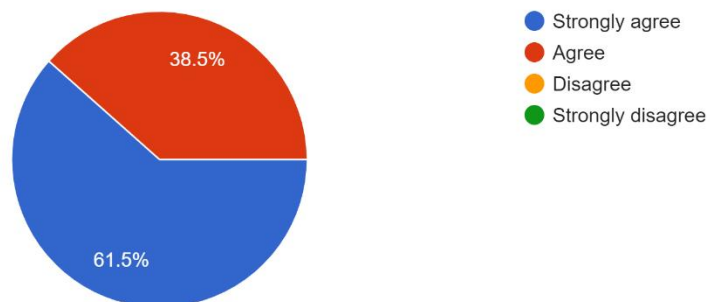
My child feels like they belong here, as part of our Grove Street family

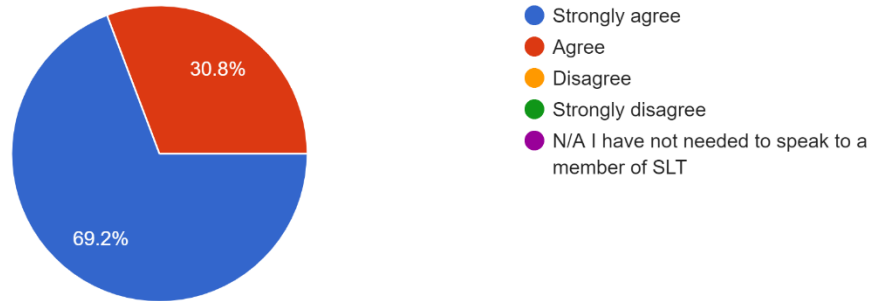
Adults at school help my child to feel safe

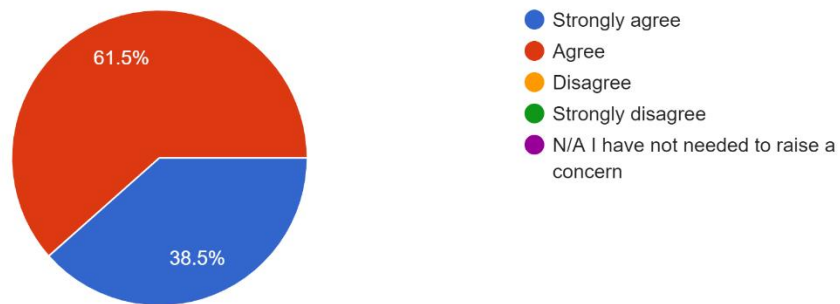

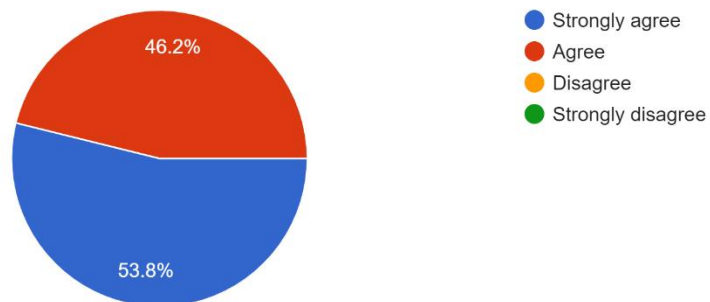
When I have raised concerns with the school they've been dealt with properly

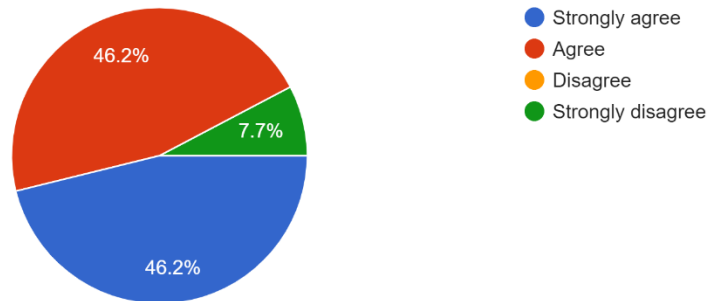
The school supports my child's mental health and wellbeing and their wider personal development

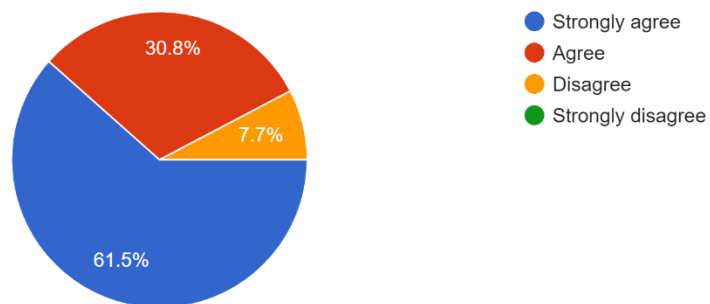
The school supports my family E.g. food (our supermarket), free uniform, being a friendly ear, suggesting other support

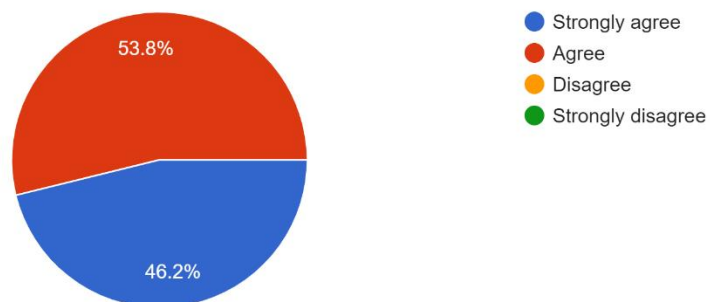
The school is good at communicating with parents (e.g. Class Dojo, face to face, phone calls, website, texts)

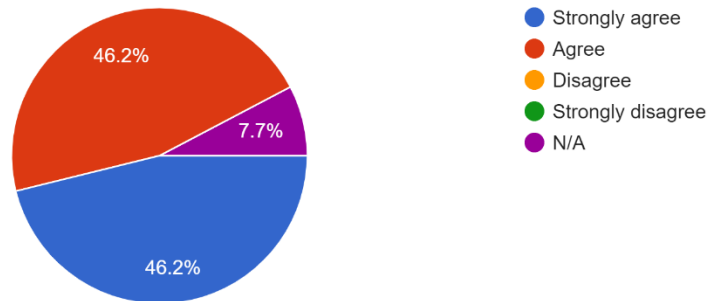
The school gives my child the support they need to succeed

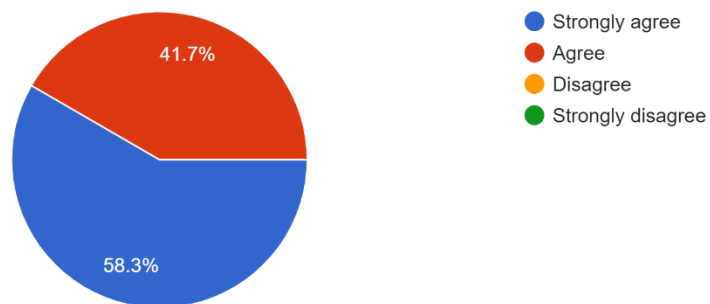
The school gives my child the support they need to prepare for their next steps e.g. high school, Reception class etc.

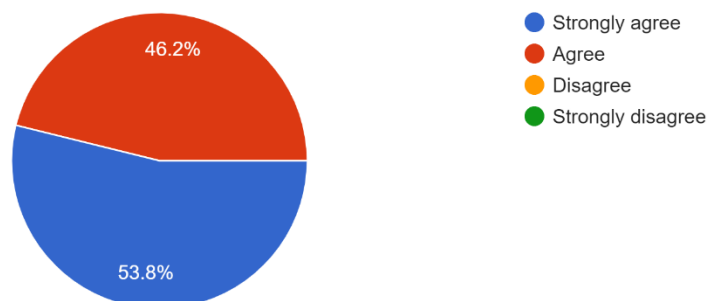
